Architectural Approval Important Reminder

Article III, Section 3.04 of our Protective Covenants states that all exterior changes or alterations must be approved by the Architectural Review Committee (ARC). **This requirement includes but is not limited to re-roofing, exterior painting, fencing, room additions, and landscaping.** Residents who want to change any part of the exterior of their home must present a detailed proposal to the Weatherly Architectural Review Committee for review prior to beginning work or awarding contracts. The provision in our covenants is there to protect the value of our neighborhood and maintain a certain standard of quality for everyone.

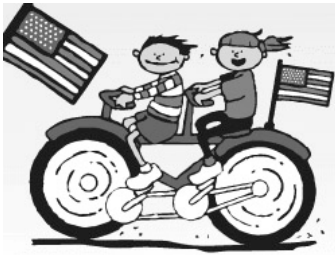
